Feelings Observation Needs Requests

The concrete actions we observe that affect our well-being.

How we feel in relation to what we observe.

The needs, values, and desires that create our feelings.

The concrete actions we request to enrich our lives.

"When you (name a behavior)..."

"I feel (name your feeling)..."

"because I want (identify what you desire)"

"and I would appreciate it if (state your request)."

Step 1: Making Observations, Not Judgements

- Judgement: My cat is so smart
 - Observation: My cat got an A on its spelling test
- Judgement: The WNBA is the best team is history
 - Observation: The WNBA has never been defeated
- Judgement: My hotel floor is filled with jerks
 - Observation: My hotel floor parties late into the night
- ► Judgement: F-250 owners are rude
 - ▶ Observation: F-250 owners always park on my front lawn





- ► Last time you had a disagreement, what did you feel?
- ► What are your feeling with worst case scenario?



Step 3: Needs



- ► Last time you had a disagreement, what did you feel?
 - ▶ What did you need?
 - What did the other person feel?
 - What did the other person need?





Ensuring That Someone Is Being Heard

- ► Explaining something complex
- Saying that back to the person
- ► Receiving confirmation
