Local Government Finance Course

This course is sponsored by the North Carolina State Treasurer's Office. It provides an overview of the basics of local government finance in North Carolina from a very particular perspective. This course does not assume that you have a formal accounting education. The candidate will learn the basic job functions that are typically housed in the finance department, with attention to those found in smaller units of governments. This course will also link those functions to the requirements for all local governments found in the NC General Statutes, primarily the Local Government and Fiscal Control Act.

Small units of government often do not have the resources to send their finance professionals to these conferences. Accordingly, the Executive Committee offers a <u>limited</u> number of scholarships to **NCGFOA members** who would like to attend. The scholarship covers the costs of the course.

Scholarships are available for first-time attendees from small units of government:

- A county with a 25,000 or less population,
- A city or town with 10,000 or less population or
- A special district or public authority serving 10,000 customers or less.
